Schedule

Lessons follow a weekly schedule agreed upon by the teacher and the student or student's caregiver. Once each month, piano students gather in groups with students of similar ages and pianistic/musical skill. These classes are an essential part of the student's education and are not optional. Either the week before or after the Saturday group class, all students will not have a private lesson. For a schedule of these weeks, please see the calendar at the end of this document.

Early Childhood Music Programs (ECM) meet weekly. Please reference the full calendar for school-wide breaks.

Payment Policy

Monthly payments for private lessons are due on the first lesson of the month. Group class payments are due by the 1st class. Payment can be made via Zelle to 215-933-8286 or laurelnolin@gmail.com, cash, or by check made out to Laurel Nolin. Late payments will incur a \$10.00 late fee. To discontinue private lessons mid-semester, one full month's notice is required prior to cancellation.

Private Lessons September through May

Piano Lessons for the months of September through May are charged at a flat monthly rate. Each month, one week will substitute a **required group class** <u>in lieu of</u> **the adjacent week's private lessons**. The monthly rate includes scheduled lessons, make up lessons, piano group classes, and recitals.

1 month of 30-minute lessons: \$100 1 month of 45-minute lessons: \$150 1 month of 60-minute lesson: \$200

Private Lessons June through August

There will not be any group piano classes during the summer semester. To accommodate summer plans, students pay per lesson instead of per month. **Each piano student must have a total of 10 lessons from June to August to reserve their spot in the 2026-2027 calendar.** These lessons do not have to be once a week but are flexible in order to accommodate travel, camps, etc.

30-minute lesson: \$25.00 45-minute lesson: \$37.50 60-minute lesson: \$50.00

Travel Fee: \$5 per visit

In-home lessons* add a \$5.00 travel fee per <u>location</u>. Siblings, neighbors, friends, etc. in the same location do not incur an additional travel fee.

*Not enrolling new at-home students at this time.

Early Childhood Music

Enrollment in Sound Sprout's ECM program is divided into three semesters, fall, spring, and summer. Fall and spring classes have 15 classes per semester. Families in the summer can enroll in anywhere from 4-9 classes. Each class includes a materials fee covering the cost of family take-home materials and tuition covering \$10 per class. Only one materials fee is charged per family per class, i.e. two siblings in the same class will be charged one materials fee.

Make-up and Cancelled Lessons

Private Lessons

Up to two private lessons per semester may receive make-up lessons for any of the following reasons: illness, medical appointment, required school activity, family emergency, travel, and religious holidays. Except in the case of illness or family emergency, 24 hours' notice is required in order to qualify for a makeup lesson. Unexcused absences include traffic/travel delay and student no call/no show. If a Sound Sprouts teacher must cancel a lesson due to illness, inclement weather, or any other reason, the students will be notified as soon as possible and qualify for a make-up lesson in addition to the two student-based make-up lessons each semester.

Piano Group Classes

In the unfortunate event that a group class is unexpectedly cancelled, it will not be made up at a later date.

Early Childhood Music

If you need to miss an ECM class for any reason (illness, weather, travel, etc.), you are welcome to make up that class at another scheduled ECM class. Please contact laurelnolin@gmail.com before attending another class, so that Ms. Laurel can prepare materials and space accordingly. Students who wish to withdraw from an ECM class mid-semester will not receive a refund.

No Shows and Late Arrivals

No shows will not receive makeup lessons. Students late to their lessons are not entitled to their full lesson length beyond the scheduled end time. Sound Sprouts reserves the right to discontinue lessons or classes due to inconsistent attendance or persistent lateness.

Practice Policy

Practice instructions will be provided on a weekly basis by the teacher. Students are expected to follow practice requirements in order to maximize their learning. Each student will have their own personalized instructions for what practice routine best suits their needs. Common strategies include slow tempi, short sections, and repetitions. The practicing process will not always sound lovely, but should be respected by the student and members of his/her living unit. In addition, persons living in the same house as the student should respect the student's space and time

during practice sessions. If acoustic, the piano should be well-tuned for efficient practicing and musical development. If digital, an ideal keyboard has 88 weighted keys and a sustain pedal. Keyboards without these functions may service the first year of study but will eventually need to be replaced by an instrument that meets the above description.

In-home Lessons*

In-home lessons must take place in a quiet, uninterrupted, smoke-free environment. Pets are not an issue. The piano must be regularly tuned and in full working condition. As mentioned above, in-home lessons incur a \$5.00 travel fee. At least one other older child or adult must be present in the living space during in-home lessons. This could be a babysitter, significantly older sibling, adult relative, or trusted friend. This person's presence is not needed in the room of the lesson but should be within earshot.

FAQ

Why is December still the full monthly fee if we only receive piano instruction for three weeks?

While December may only have three weeks of instruction, the fall semester from Sept-Dec includes sixteen weeks of instruction. By keeping a flat monthly rate this semester, payments are more straightforward and even out to a 4-week month with each payment.

Will we still have Early Childhood Music classes if there are no piano lessons? Many times, piano students will attend a group class in lieu of their private lesson. For most of these weeks, ECM programs are still in session. However, school-wide closures in December, January, and March do affect both piano lessons and ECM programs. Please reference the calendar below.
